Artist Tips

Before applying, visit some of the listings in this guide to determine which venues are the best match for you. Alternative spaces are a good place to begin. Most commercial galleries expect an established body of work and an exhibition history before representing an artist.

Contact venues first to ask about selection procedures:

- Do not expect anyone to review your work without an appointment. Most venues review digital images or printouts first. If there is interest, a studio visit might be requested.

When sending your proposal:

- For electronic entries, request the proper digital format in advance.
- Label each submission in your e-mail or jumpdrive with your name, title, date, media, and dimensions.
- If sending a physical copy of your proposal, include a self-addressed stamped envelope to ensure the return of your materials, or assume they will be discarded.
- Track responses and returns to better strategize your efforts.

Feel free to ask:

- Is there a fee for applying and/or for use of the space?
- Who will install the work—you or their staff?
- Are there security measures, climate control, insurance coverage, etc.?
- Do they offer honorariums or can they assist with the budget?
- When can you expect a reply or return of your materials?

And finally, rejection is a routine part of the application process. Don't get discouraged. Acceptances and rejections are based on a wide range of criteria upon which you have little to no control.

A Guide to Categories in the *Exhibition Opportunities Guide*:

Art Show

An art display, typically outdoors, with many participating artists.

(See: Summerfair Cincinnati)

Artists Studios/Collective

A group of studios or artists that periodically hosts exhibitions of visual arts or cultural events.

(See: Tiger Lily Press)

Arts Publication/Web Site

A resource that promotes and reviews the arts and/or keeps artists informed of opportunities.

(See: *Aeqai*)

Café/Restaurant/Bar/Salon

A site dedicated to formal/informal dining or personal well-being that also features visual art displays, usually for sale.

(See: Iris BookCafé)

Collaborative Performance Environment

A site used to conduct performances, parties, etc., that also displays visual art.

(See: Leapin Lizard Event Space)

Commercial/Co-Op

An establishment dedicated to the exhibition and sale of artwork usually managed as an association by the featured artists.

(See: 5th Street Gallery)

Commercial Gallery

An establishment dedicated to the sale of artwork and the promotion of collecting art.

(See: Carl Solway Gallery)

Community Meeting Space

A facility that hosts a variety of meetings or classes which also has space for visual art.

(See: Baker-Hunt Art & Cultural Center)

Educational Institution

A site for the pursuit of education or academic degrees which includes a visual art exhibition space.

(See: Xavier University Art Gallery)

Museum

A site with an educational mission dedicated to collecting and/or exhibiting artwork, set against the backdrop of a permanent collection.

(See: Taft Museum of Art)

Non-Commercial

A site for the exhibition of artwork that does not pursue official non-profit status and is therefore directed solely by its owners, with infrequent sales.

(See: Cincinnati Art Club – Wessel Gallery)

Non-Profit

A site officially designated by IRS non-profit status dedicated to the promotion and exhibition of art/artists without the necessity of artwork sales.

(See: Weston Art Gallery)

Public Space/Corporate Office

A site generally open to the public such as an atrium or passageway and/or a workspace that has a finished public gallery, corridor, or a semi-private board room.

(See: 21c Museum Hotel)

Religious Institution

A site for the practice of organized religion that includes a visual art exhibition space.

(See: Gallery South at Christ Church Cathedral)

Retail Space

A site whose primary focus is the sale of items other than art. Sale of artwork is secondary.

(See: NVISION)
